PAPERLESS ORDER: The Court grants 98 the Plaintiffs' unopposed motion for leave to file a second amended complaint and 103 the Defendants' unopposed motion to extend the deadline to respond to the Plaintiffs' second amended complaint. Rule 15(a)(2) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure instructs that "[t]he court should freely give leave when justice so requires." Here, the proposed amendments to the complaint are to streamline and simplify the arguments rather than to add allegations that would prejudice the Defendants at a late stage, and the Defendants do not oppose the proposed amendments. The Plaintiffs shall file the second amended complaint by October 4, 2023. The Court also grants 103 the Defendants' unopposed motion to extend the deadline to respond to the second amended complaint; the Defendants' response is therefore due within 30 days of the filing of the second amended complaint.
